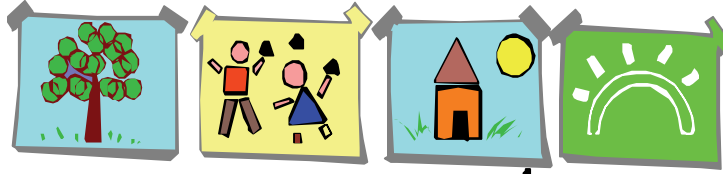

# Winterfest

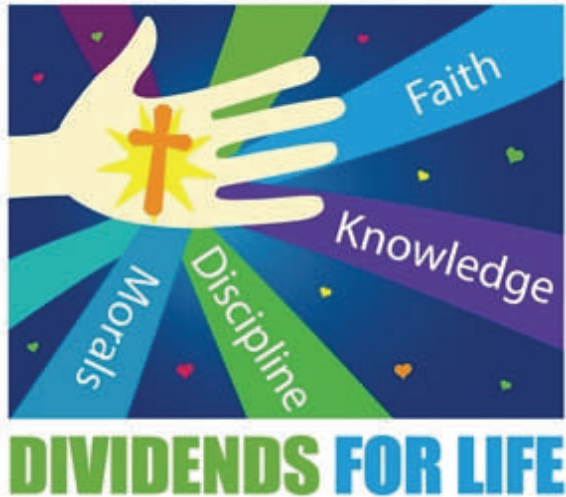
