3 years-old by 12/1/2012

Three and five day program, age requirements:

4 years-old by 12/1/2012, and young 5's.

### Classes Offered:

Ages 3 to Young 5:

Half Day: 8:50AM - 11:20AM (3-5 yr. olds)

Full Day: 8:50AM - 2:20PM (3-5 yr. olds)

Mon-Fri: 8:50AM - 2:20PM (4 & 5 yr. olds)

### Registration:

Pick up an application/registration packet in the school office, available February 1st. Upon return of the completed forms, a state birth certificate, and a \$40 non-refundable registration fee paid to St. Ann School, your child will be enrolled for the 2012/2013 school year.

### Other Requirements:

Each child must have a health form on file at the beginning of the school year and must be completely toilet-trained.

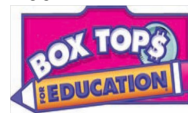

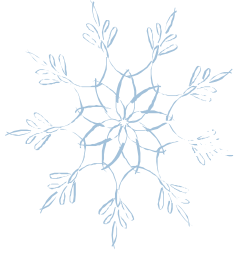

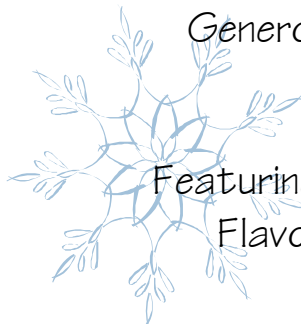

# February 2012 Hot Lunch Menu

Fruits and vegetables come in all shapes and sizes. It is not surprising that they all grow in different places, some on trees, some on plants, some on vines, and others in the ground!

**Q** What makes a fruit a fruit?

**A** Fruits are generally sweet and have seeds on the inside.

**Q** What makes a vegetable a vegetable?

**A** Vegetables are edible parts of plants (leaves, roots, stems, etc.), but are generally not sweet like fruit.

**Q** Where do they grow?

**A** Fruits and vegetables can grow in many different places. Check the list below to find out where your favorite fruits and vegetables come from.

Root: carrot, potato, radish, sweet potato

Leaf: cabbage greens, lettuce, spinach

Tree: apple, apricot, banana, orange

Plant: artichoke, pineapple, tomato

Vine: grapes, kiwi, squash, watermelon

Stalk: broccoli, celery, asparagus, rhubarb
